Registration

All attendees to the 2010 meeting must submit a registration form available from the PRS web site to the PRS Office. The Park Hyatt Beaver Creek will not accept reservations directly from members. A credit card will be requested by the hotel upon check in for optional personal expenses incurred during the stay.

Pre/Post Stay

Transportation

Altitude

Altitude in Avon, Colorado is 7,431 feet above sea level. Travelers are strongly encouraged to drink plenty of water prior to and during the meeting to minimize effect of the change in altitude as well as consume alcohol in moderation.

4 Eagle Ranch
